- Reports, presented at the conference, will be published as scientific articles prior the conference. The publication will be available for purchase starting the first day of the conference .
- Articles for publication in this compendium should be submitted, as MS Word documents, to the coordinator of the conference no later than February 15, 2014. Articles should comply with the following:
 - Length should not exceed 6-10 pages (about 15 000 characters), Font size – 14, Line spacing – 1,5.
 - A short resume at the beginning of the article should contain main objective of the article and show the most important problems considered and conclusions drawn.
 - Keywords should follow the short resume,
 - Summary at the end – 1 page.
 - Articles should be in English, with the Summary in any other language (Latvian, Lithuanian, Estonian, Swedish, German or other).
 - Footnotes: bottom of page with continuous numeration.
 - Articles that diverge from these rules may be refused publication.
